General Information

All monthly bills for services rendered and minimum charges are due and payable within 20 days from their date, and if not so paid, become delinquent. Upon failure of the customer to pay his bill on or before the delinquent date he shall be deemed in default, and a penalty of 5% will be added and the service may be discontinued without notice. The right is reserved to refuse service to anyone who is indebted to the Utilities. Failure to receive mail will not be recognized as a valid excuse for failure to pay bills when due. Payment should be made either by mail or in person at the Business Office. All payments should be accompanied by the bill stubs to permit proper identification. Information regarding bills, or of regulations, or of any additional service or rates may be obtained at the Business Office.

Service Requirements

The customer shall obtain and grant all necessary permission to enable the Utility to install the service and perform its contract. All wiring, entrance switches and cabinets shall be of approved design and shall have been inspected and passed by the local Electrical Inspector or a representative of the Utility. The Utility shall have the right, through its agent or authorized employee to enter upon the premises of the customer at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspecting, repairing or removing any and/or all of the equipment, appliances and wiring of the Utility.

Trouble Calls

For reporting "Lights Out" or similar trouble call phone "10" between the hours 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. At other times call Black 227. If the trouble is found on the customer's premises a charge will be made for labor and materials.

Specific instances of unsatisfactory service or troubles from defective equipment should be promptly reported to the Main Office or the Department Superintendent or the Chief Operator.

Resale of Service

Unless otherwise provided by contract, the customer shall not resell the electric energy, water, or telephone service furnished under this tariff for use on the premises occupied by the customer ordering such service.

Tax Additions

All rates are subject to proportional increases to compensate for any gross revenue, kilowatt hour or other form of tax imposed by any municipal, territorial or federal taxing body.

Rates

Copies of all rate schedules are on file at our Business Office and are open, during office hours, to public inspection upon request.

Terms—The rates are based on twelve months continuous service. No service will be accepted for less than three (3) months except as provided by appropriate schedules. The rates charged in these schedules may be obtained at the office.

Unless otherwise stated all rates listed herein are applicable only within the city limits of Ketchikan.

A condensed schedule of rates within the limits of Ketchikan covering the most commonly used classes of services are listed on following pages.

Telephone Information

In order to assist us in giving prompt and efficient service our customers are requested to comply with the following regulations and suggestions:

Obtain telephone numbers from the latest Telephone Directory.

CALL BY NUMBER ONLY. When an operator is required to look up a name and number the service both to you and to others is delayed.

If the name is not found in the directory ask for "Information" and note the number in the directory for future reference.

Speak directly into the mouthpiece of your telephone with your lips close to it.

If the line you are calling is busy you will hear an instrument buzzing at regular intervals. This signal is known as the "Busy Back." Hang up and call later.

On calls to party lines the "busy back" report does not necessarily mean that the particular telephone called is busy but that some telephone on that line is in use.

LIMIT CALLS TO THREE MINUTES.

ORDERS FOR SERVICE

To arrange for the installation of new service please call at the Business Office where the proper application blanks will be provided for signature. If you wish telephone instruments moved from one location or address to another, or service discontinued, please notify the Business Office, preferably sufficiently in advance so that the work may be performed at the time you require it done.

NUMBER CHANGES

Changing telephone numbers is often unavoidable and we appreciate that it often results in some inconvenience to our customers. However, to meet the increasing demands for service it is sometimes necessary to make certain rearrangements in our equipment. Your co-operation in such adjustments is appreciated.

INSTALLATION AND MOVING CHARGES

All rates are service rates and do not include any charge for labor or material for installing, moving or connecting of any telephone.

These charges are as follows:

For new installations there will be a minimum charge of	\$3.50
For connecting or installing a telephone where no house wiring or interior labor is required	1.00
For all interior moves from one location to another in the same premises, minimum charge	2.00
For exterior moves from one address or location to another where the premises are wired for telephone service, minimum	1.00
Installation of extension phone, same premises, minimum	1.50
Change of instruments or classification on customer's order	1.00

The moving, adjusting, painting, and/or otherwise marking any of the property of the Utility is forbidden. Any damage to receivers, transmitters, cords and/or any other part of any instrument through use, abuse, and/or accident will be billed the customer at the cost of such repairs.

Ordinary conversations are limited to three minutes and the right is reserved to interrupt or discontinue any use exceeding that time.

Electric Service

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "A"—Residential Service

Availability: This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan. This service covers energy supplied for residence purposes, including lighting and cooking, to individual (single family) residences and apartments. Single phase motor installations with a total connected load not exceeding 5 h.p. may be connected and served by this rate if used for residential purposes. All of the electrical appliances to be served under this rate are subject to approval by the Utilities.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A.C., at nominal 115/230 volts.

Rate:

First 50 KWH per month	@ 6c per KWH
Next 100 KWH per month	@ 3c per KWH
All Over 150 KWH per month	@ 1c per KWH
Minimum Charge	\$1.00 per meter per month

General Provisions:

(1) If two or more residences or apartments are served through one meter, the rate shall be multiplied by the number of residences or apartments thus served.

(2) The electric energy for common facilities, such as furnaces, heating plants, laundry rooms, etc., for not more than two individual (single family) residences or apartments in one building may be supplied through the meter serving one of the individual residences under this schedule.

(3) Religious and charitable institutions, schools, and hospitals, at the option of the Utilities may be classified under this schedule.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "A-1"—Residential Service

Availability: (1) This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan and within the area from Mile 7 on North Tongass Highway to Mile 7 on South Tongass Highway. This service covers energy supplied to customers in single family residences and apartments using electric service exclusively for lighting, cooking, and for water heating requirements where such service can be supplied through a single meter.

(2) Twin unit storage tanks shall be insulated and of 40-gallons minimum capacity, heated by two non-inductive 230 volt elements, thermostatically controlled, with maximum allowable capacities of fifty (50) watts per gallon of tank capacity for the upper element and twenty-five (25) watts per gallon for the lower element. Single unit storage tanks shall be insulated and of 30-gallons minimum capacity heated by one non-inductive 230 volt, element thermostatically controlled with maximum allowable heating capacity of 3-KW.

(3) All installations and equipment shall be subject to the approval of the Utilities as to type and capacity of heating units, tanks, controls and insulation. The Utilities reserve the right to control the use of any or all heating units during such hours as it may deem advisable.

(4) Single phase motor installations totalling 5 h.p. or less may be connected under this schedule.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A.C., nominal 115/230 volts.

First 50 KWH per month	@ 6c per KWH
Next 100 KWH per month	@ 3c per KWH
All over 150 KWH per month	@ 1c per KWH
Minimum Charge	\$1.00 per meter per month

General provisions: Same as provided in Electric Schedule "A."

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "H"—Water Heating Service (Residential or Commercial) Separately Metered

Availability: This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan and within the area from Mile 7 on North Tongass Highway to Mile 7 on South Tongass Highway. This service applies exclusively to use for heating water electrically with properly insulated storage tank heaters under the following general provisions:

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A.C., at nominal 230 volts

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

(1) At the option of the Utilities, service to water heaters may be limited to a maximum use of eighteen hours per day.

(2) Service shall be metered on a circuit which shall include all of the heaters for one or more storage tanks but exclude all other service.

(3) Service under this schedule may be limited to 3 KW capacity at the Utilities' option. The following are maximum allowable capacities for tank heaters:

- 30 gallon tanks or smaller 3000 Watts.
- 40 gallon tanks 75 Watts per gallon of tank capacity.
- Over 40 gallon tanks 60 Watts per gallon of tank capacity.

(4) Heating elements shall be non-inductive, thermostatically controlled and installations in excess of 3 KW shall consist of two elements, each to be controlled by a thermostat. One element shall be placed to heat the whole tank and the other to heat the upper part of the tank. The capacity of the upper element shall not exceed twice that of the lower element.

(5) All installations and equipment shall be subject to the approval of the Utilities as to type and capacity of heating units, tanks, controls and insulation.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "AB"—Small Boat Service

Availability: This schedule applies to service to boats moored at public floats where electric service is available.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A.C. at nominal 115/230 volts.

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

(1) All rates are net and payable in advance. Payment to be made to the representative of the Utilities at the float.

(2) Connections to the outlet provided on the float must be made with an approved rubber covered extension cord. Such cords are subject to the inspection and approval of the Utilities' representative.

(3) No service will be accepted for less than one month, except by special arrangement.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "B" General Commercial Service

Availability: This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan. This service covers energy supplied for lighting and power purposes in commercial establishments where capacity of connected appliance load is not in excess of 10 KW.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A. C at nominal 115/230 volts

First 100 KWH per month	@ 6c per KWH
Next 300 KWH per month	@ 3c per KWH
All Over 400 KWH per month	@ 2c per KWH
Minimum Charge:	\$1.00 per meter per month

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "C"

Commercial Lighting, Heating, Cooking, Refrigeration and Appliance Service

Availability: This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan. This service covers energy supplied for lighting, heating, cooking, refrigeration and appliance service in commercial establishments where capacity of connected load is in excess of 10 KW and the average load factor is 20% or more based on a demand of 50% of connected load.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single, two, or three phase, 60 cycles, A. C., at nominal 115/230 volts at the option of the Utilities, depending upon the class of service available.

Rate:
 First 200 KWH per month @ 6c per KWH
 Next 200 KWH per month @ 3c per KWH
 All over 400 KWH per month @ 1c per KWH
Minimum Charge:\$1.00 per meter per month.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "D" General Power

Availability: This schedule is available within the city limits of Ketchikan wherever system facilities are adequate. This service covers energy supplied for general power of one horsepower or over.

Character of Service: (1) Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single, two or three phase, 60 cycles, A. C., at nominal 115/230, 460 or 4160 volts at the option of the Utilities, depending upon the class of service available.

(2) This schedule is based on twelve months continuous service.

Rate:
 First 75 KWH per H. P. of monthly demand per month @ 4c per KWH.
 Excess @ 1c per KWH.

Demand. The determination of demand shall be:
 One motor 100 percent of connected horsepower.
 Two or more motors 50 per cent of connected horsepower.

Minimum Charge:
 The minimum bill per month connected horsepower \$0.50
 But in no case shall the minimum be less than \$1.00

Discount
 A quantity discount will be allowed based on connected load as follows:

From one to 20 H. P. connected load	5%
From 21 to 100 H. P. connected load	10%
From 101 to 200 H. P. connected load	20%
From 201 to 300 H. P. connected load	30%
From 301 to 500 H. P. connected load	40%
From 501 to 650 H. P. connected load	45%
Over 650 H. P.	50%

Note: The quantity discount will not apply if the gross billing less the quantity discount is less than the minimum bill.

ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE "R" Residential Service—Rural

Availability: This schedule is available outside the city limits of Ketchikan for residential service.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A. C., at nominal 115/230 volts.

Rate:
 First 7 KWH per month \$1.00
 Next 33 KWH per month @ 8c per KWH
 Next 110 KWH per month @ 4c per KWH
 All over 150 KWH per month @ 1c per KWH
Minimum Charge: \$1.00 per meter per month.

General Provisions: (1) On and after November 1, 1941, in the area North or beyond Mile 7, North Tongass Highway, and beyond or South of Mile 7, South Tongass Highway, no modification of this schedule will be made nor any other rate applied for residential electric service.

(2) This schedule is based on twelve months' continuous service. If applied to service six months or less, a connection charge of \$3.00 will be made. No application will be accepted for less than six months service.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "RC" Commercial General—Rural

Availability: This schedule is available outside the city limits of Ketchikan for general commercial service.

Character of Service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single phase, 60 cycle, A. C. at nominal 115/230 volts.

Rate:
 First 200 KWH per month @ 7½c per KWH
 Next 200 KWH per month @ 3½c per KWH
 All Over 400 KWH per month @ 2½c per KWH
Minimum Charge \$3.00 per meter per month.

ELECTRIC SCHEDULE "RP"

General Power—Rural

Availability: This schedule is available outside the city limits of Ketchikan wherever system facilities are adequate. This service covers energy supplied for general power purposes.

Character of service: Energy delivered under this schedule shall be single or three phase, 60 cycles A. C., at nominal 230, 460 or 4160 volts at the option of the Utilities, depending upon the class of service available.

Rate:
 First 75 KWH per H. P. of monthly demand @ 6c per KWH
 Excess @ 1c per KWH

Demand: The determination of demand shall be:
 One motor—100 per cent of connected hrsepower.
 Two or more motors—75 per cent of connected horsepower.

Minimum charge:
 The minimum bill per month per connected horsepower \$1.25

Discount: A quantity discount will be allowed, based on connected load as follows:

From 1 to 20 horsepower connected load	5 per cent
From 21 to 100 horsepower connected load	10 per cent
From 101 to 200 horsepower connected load	20 per cent
Over 200	30 per cent

Apply to the office for additional rates and services.

Note: The quantity discount will not apply if the gross billing less the quantity discount is less than the minimum bill.

Terms: This rate is based on twelve months' continuous service.

Water Service

RESIDENTIAL OR DOMESTIC SERVICE—SCHEDULE A

Applicable to one customer at one premise. Establishments jointly occupied by more than one family shall be billed proportionately.

 Each additional cold water tap, bath, lavatory, sink, or faucet25

The right is reserved by the Utility to refuse service to anyone who is indebted to the Utility. For rates for water construction purposes, see schedule "G." All rates, except where otherwise specified, apply to service connections not over ¾ inch.


