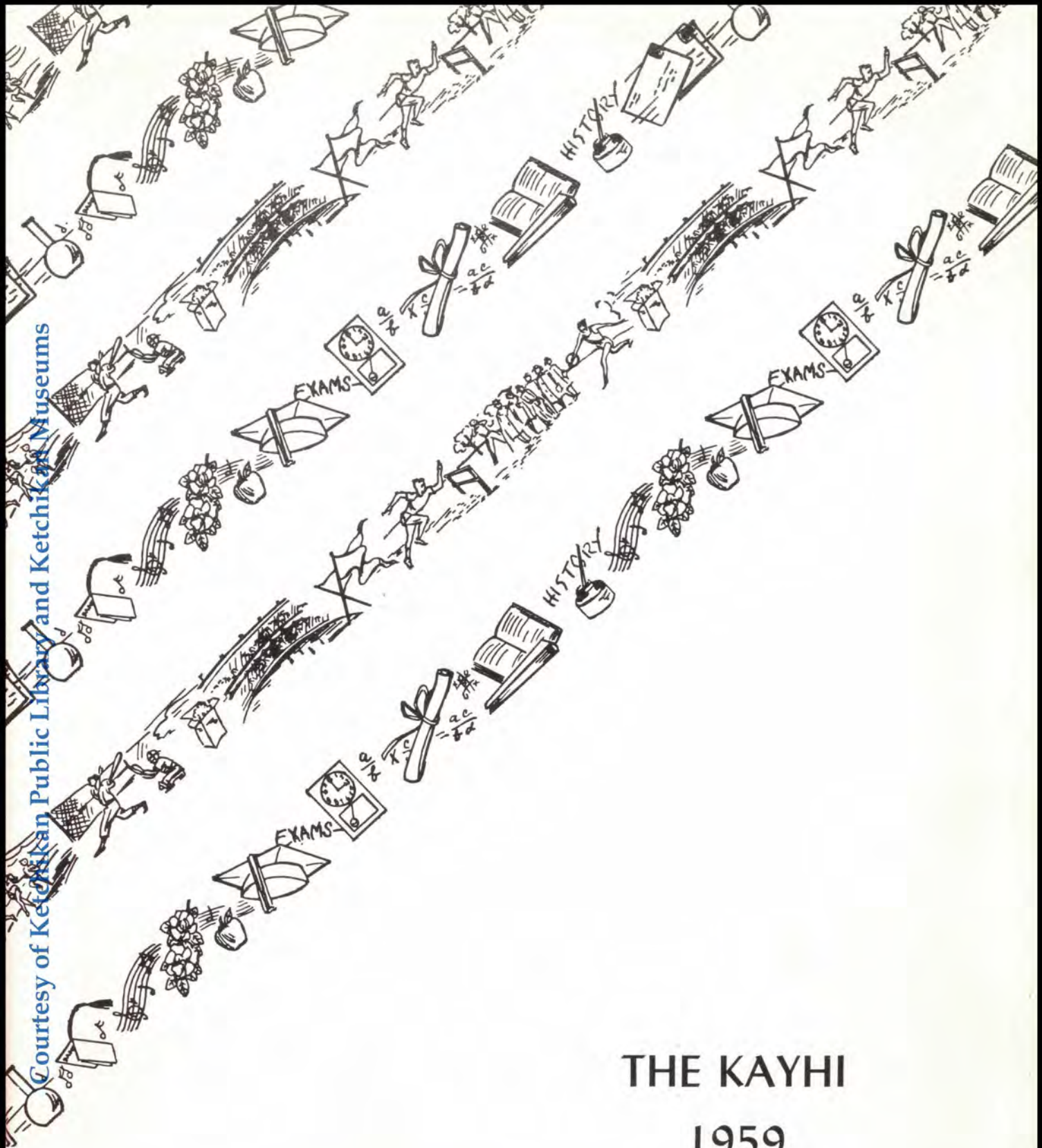

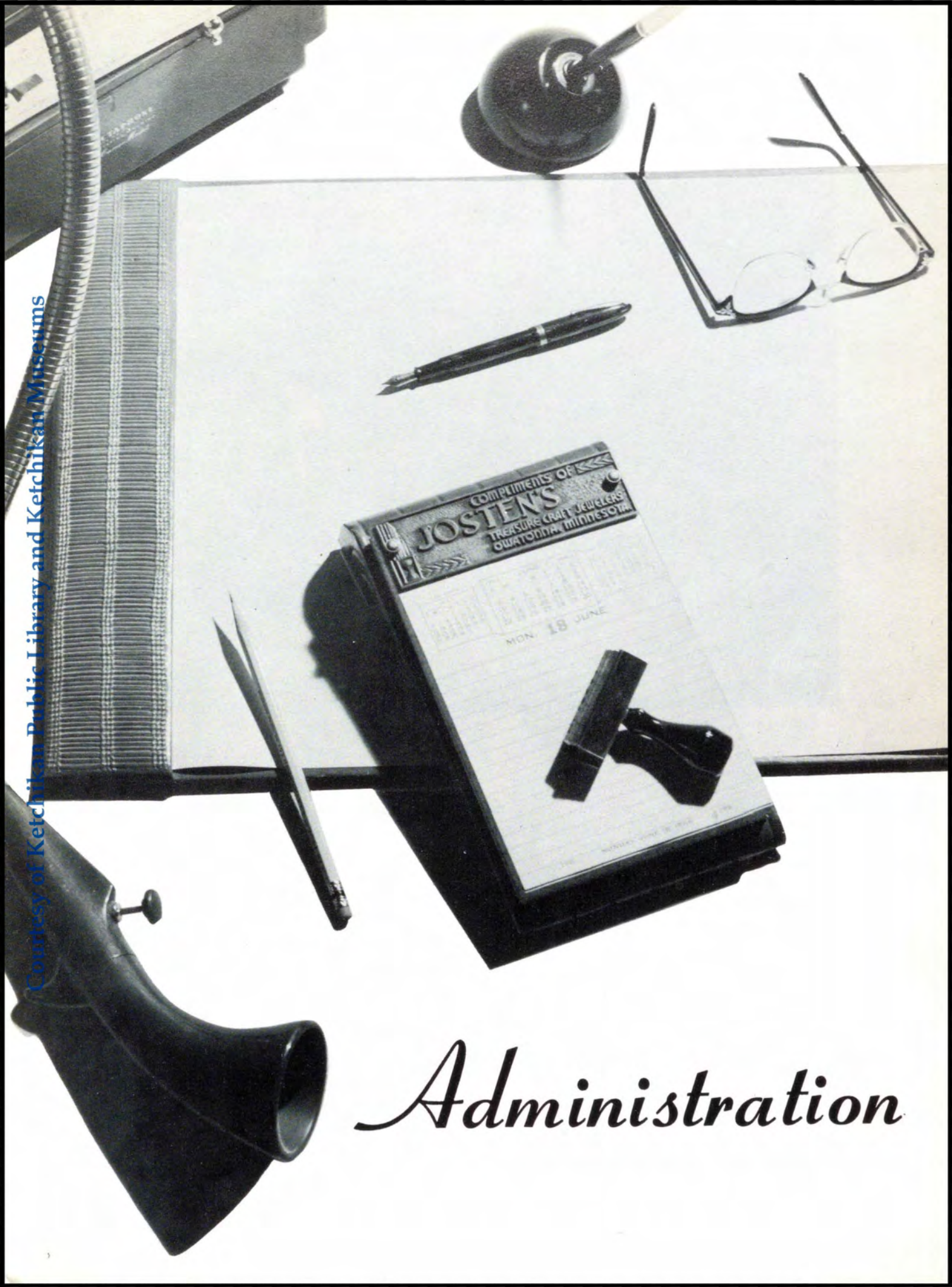

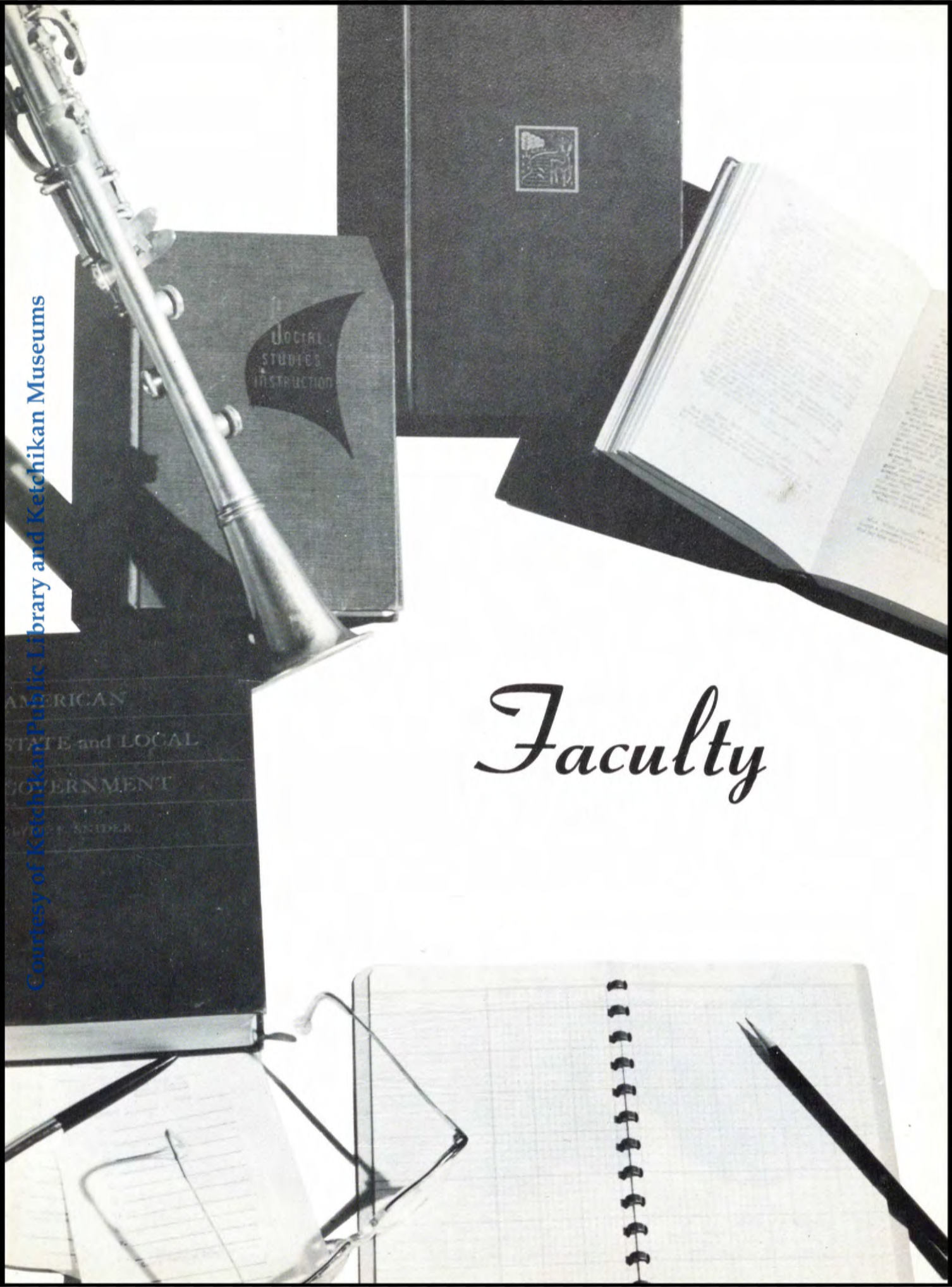

Our next undertaking was the Junior Jinx, which was a success both financially and socially. In the spring, we worked hard, organizing and decorating for our Junior Prom. The theme was "Symphony of Spring." During the rest of the year we studied and looked forward to our last year at Kayhi.

Then we took the final step--our Senior year! Our class was led by Dale Pihlman, President, Danny Canfield, Vice-President, Ronnie Hall, Sgt. at Arms, Joanne Chiabra, Secretary, and Karen Robertson, Treasurer.
