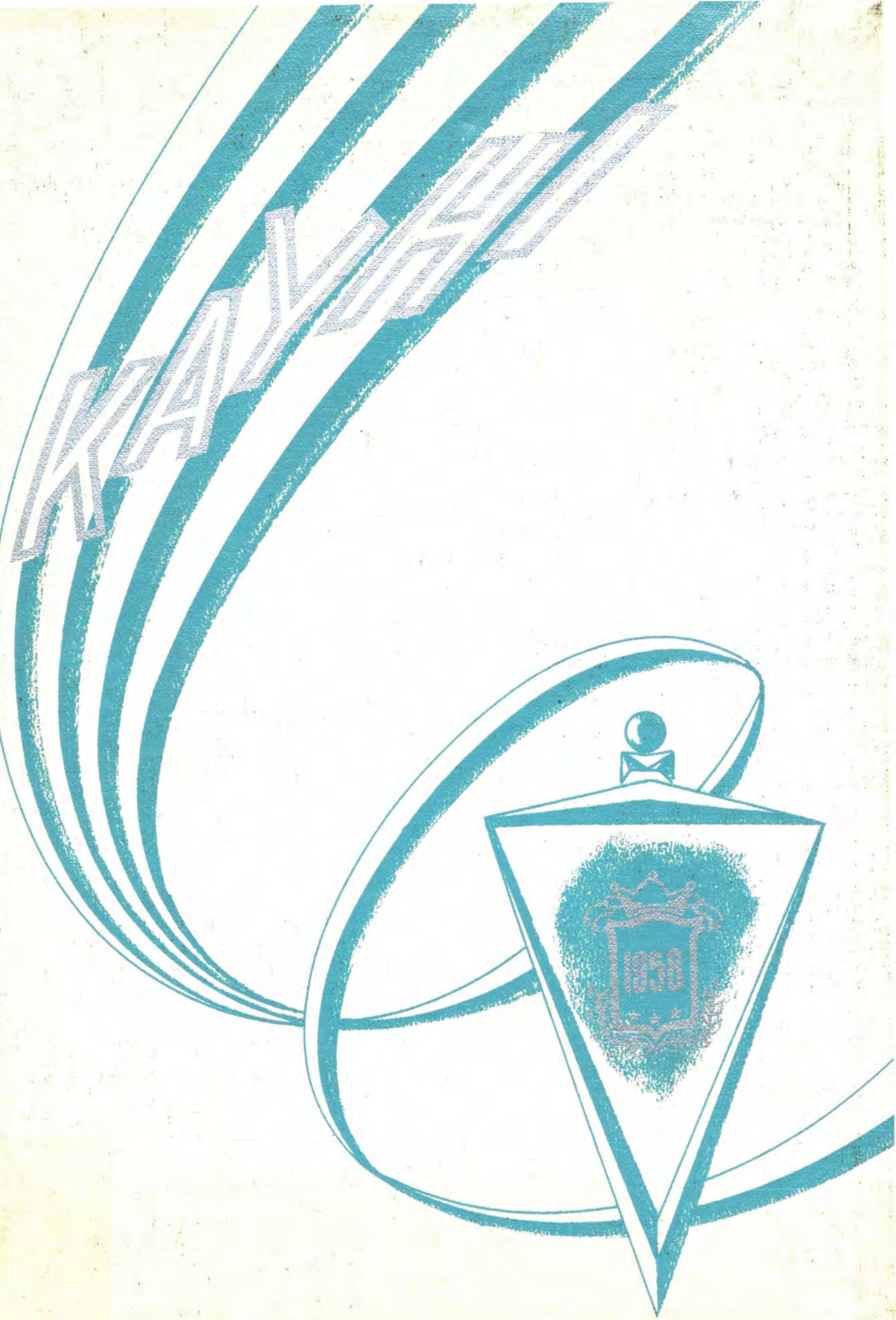

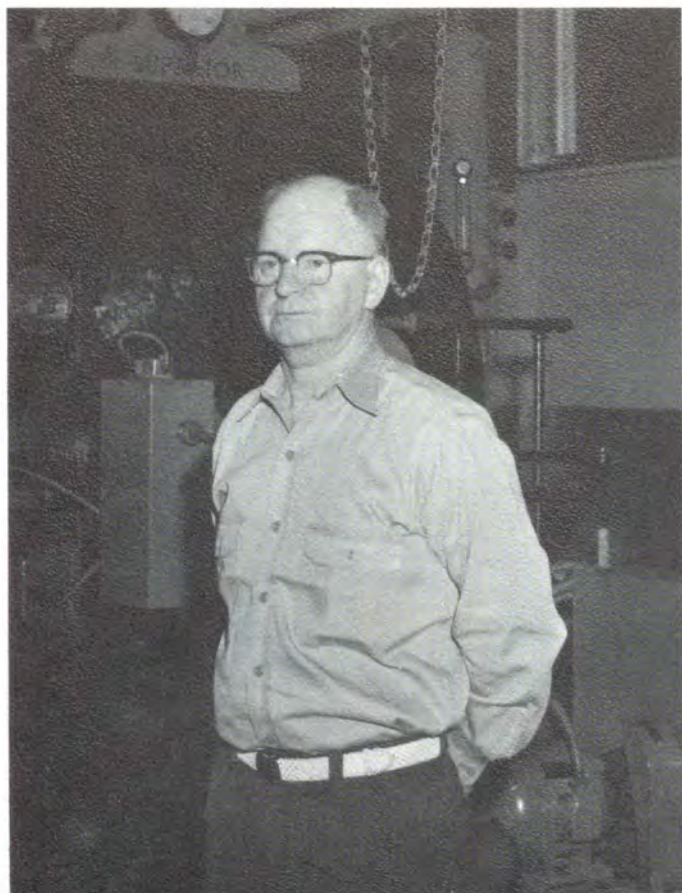
Cafeteria
